Fixing & Joining Pegs

Our Garden Edge Pegs are crafted from durable aluminium and designed for fast, secure installation. Each peg features a **280mm pointed stake** that drives firmly into the ground, providing strong anchoring in all soil types. Available in two sizes:



SP20F

Installation Guides

1. Clear away any existing edging or obstacles.
2. Mark out and plan the desired garden edge layout.
3. Cut a neat trench into the ground using a spade.
4. Position the Garden Edge strip into the trench and adjust the depth to the required height.
5. Secure the strip with fixing pegs, driving them firmly into the soil with a hammer.
6. For longer runs, use joining pegs to connect strips and create a seamless finish.
7. Corners can be formed by cutting and butting the strips together.
